YOUR 2ND AMENDMENT RIGHTS ARE IN DANGER!

California politicians are actively working to systematically eliminate what remains of our Second Amendment Rights through a series of bills, now being deemed "Gunpocalypse 2016". At the time of this print, these Bills are waiting to be heard by the Assembly, and will likely land at Governor Brown's desk shortly. We need YOUR help to put an end to these pointless and useless bills. There is a storm brewing in Sacramento, and our 2nd Amendment Rights are caught in the eye.

In this brochure, you will find a Bill breakdown, 2nd Amendment supporter information, and contact information for these anti-gun politicians. It is imperative that we spread the word about these bills to other 2nd Amendment supporters, get in touch with these politicians and make our opposition to these bills known.

THE OBJECTIVE

- To notify and make aware those who have not heard about the Senate and Assembly Bills against CA 2nd Amendment Rights.
- To gain support from gun owners, business operators, and industry professionals.
- To organize a streamlined, unified, professional, likeminded, boisterous and respectful group of protestors who speak harmoniously against these unconstitutional bills/laws.
- To peacefully gather and protest in Sacramento and local political offices.

WHO IT AFFECTS

- Gun Owners; Centerfire pistols and rifles, Curio & Relic firearms, Rifle's with Bullet Buttons, 80% (unserialized) firearms, restraining orders by family/friends/employer, high ammo prices, ammo purchasing certificate/database, limit firearms purchases per month.
- Businesses; Ammo vending license, additional surveillance, Bullet Button firearms ban, records retention, limits sales.

“GUTTING & AMENDING”

“The controversial practice of stripping out a measure's contents and replacing it with entirely new language, for a new issue, well into the legislative process”

Sen. De Leon, Asm.'s McCarty, Ting, Levine, and Chiu have gutted 4 Bills, (previously targeting global warming, greenhouse gases, groundwater sustainability, emissions, and energy conservation), and replaced their text to target gun ownership and lending, curio and relic firearms, and ammunition sales.

These bills are being “fast tracked” in an effort to subvert any opportunity the people may have to weigh in on these topics and our political process is being by-passed to take away the tools needed to prevent the government from imposing its will.

THE BILLS

- *AB156 - Bans/Restrictions on common ammo purchases 1, 2
- *AB857 - Requires all firearms to be serialized, retroactive ghost guns 1, 2
- *AB1135- Bans Bullet Button firearms 5, 7
- *AB1511- Criminalizes loaning firearms 6
- AB 1663 - Expands AW definition to include BB, C&R firearms 4, 5, 7, 12
- AB1664 - Expands AW definition to include BB 4, 5, 7
- AB1673 - Expands firearm definition to include firearm materials (i.e. raw aluminum blocks & sheet steel to make receivers) 8
- AB1674 - Limits purchases of ALL firearms to 1 per month 4, 6
- AB1695 - Expands threatening letters from DOJ 14
- AB2510 - Eliminates CCW uniformity 13
- AB2607 - Expands gun restraining orders 5
- SB880 - Bans firearms with BB 8, 9, 10, 11
- SB894 - Time limit to report lost/stolen guns 15
- SB1006 - U. of CA gun violence research using tax payer money 1, 16
- SB1235 - Bans/Restricts ammo purchases 1, 2
- SB1407 - Requires all firearms to be serialized, retroactive Ghost Gun registration 1, 15
- SB1446 - Bans lawfully owned 10+ mags 11, 14
